<b>Legislative</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Three Hills Victim Services requested support for their First Responder dinner, approved for \$350.00 donation.</li> <li>• Youth Sponsorship Request: Acme School Senior Girls Volleyball team to receive \$900.00 in funds to participate in the Provincial tournament.</li> <li>• Christmas Closure for Kneehill County: Office will be closed from December 25, 2017, through to January 1, 2018.
