Delegations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Una Erickson presents the Kneehill Area Wellness Centre initiatives, including little libraries, Torrington activities and small community awareness.
Finance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New Master Rates Bylaw 1777 was approved. Changes were made to planning fees, water and garbage fees, Ag equipment and parks fees. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Council made changes to the following water rates: Huxley, Wimborne, Equity and Mount Vernon up to \$2.00/m³, Swalwell, Torrington, Sunnyslope, Churchill, Gamble, Grainger/Hesketh, Kirckpatrick and Sle Kirk WSA's increasing to \$3.50/m³. Bulk water rates change to \$5.00/m³ for 0-50 cubic meters monthly, and \$9.00/m³ for 100+ cubic meters monthly. Water service flat rate fee increases to \$50.00/month, and hamlet garbage pickup is now \$50.00 bimonthly per residence. Finance summarizes the Tax Recovery process which includes Council setting the Reserve Bids and Conditions of Sale. Full details for each property in the Council Package on the website. Legislative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Kneehill Regional Family and Community Support Services (KRFCSS) 2019 Budget, Council approves the allocation. KRFCSS invites community volunteers to attend the Volunteer Forum on November 7. Council approves all Councillor attendance, should they be able to attend. Bylaw 1778, Regional Assessment Review Board presented. The RARB services 20 municipalities in the Central Alberta region. Council approves Bylaw 1778. Three Hills Arts Academy Night on Broadway playing on October 25-27. Council donates the 4 complimentary tickets that came with our donation in February, back to the Academy. Disposition of delegation business (Kneehill Area Wellness Centre), taken as information. Council Committee Reports included Doctor Retention and Recruitment, Aqua 7 Regional Water Commission (contract renewals timeframe set, water pump repairs, and municipal partnerships procedure), and Drumheller Solid Waste.
