## FREE Reverse Fenceline Weed Control

Kneehill County is committed to the control of Noxious and Prohibited Noxious weeds within it's borders. A common place for these weeds and other weed species to start is in the "headlands" of cropland, the one meter buffer strip along the fenceline left unsprayed by both the ASB roadside spraying program and the crop producer.

To help with this issue and gain control of legally regulated weed species the Kneehill County ASB is offering to spray the headlands from the field back into the ditch to gain maximum weed control. This FREE service includes the UTV spray equipment, residual broadleaf herbicide and an experienced county spraying employee, a value worth approx. \$100/acre!
