If, on the first ballot, no one Councillor receives a clear majority of the votes, the Councillor who received the least number of votes shall be dropped from the ballot and second ballot shall be taken. 8. On subsequent ballots, a Councillor who receives the least number of votes shall be dropped from the ballot until a Councillor receives a clear majority. 9. After the declaration of the Reeve, the Chair will be turned over to the Reeve.




