



## KNEEHILL COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

This scholarship program was established for Kneehill County residents enrolled in a post-secondary institution. The intent of this policy is to emphasize that education is not an end in itself, but instead is a means by which people become contributing members of society. Kneehill County recognizes the importance of an educated population to the future well-being of rural communities. This scholarship program is in support of rural students attending a university, college or trade school.

### Award Value

The award will be in the form of two scholarships valued at \$2,000 each, one awarded on academic achievement in high school and one awarded on community and leadership activities.

### Eligibility Criteria

Applicant must:

- Be a rural resident of Kneehill County.
- Be enrolled in their first year as full-time student at a recognized post-secondary institution.
- Have graduated with an Alberta High School Diploma from a high school within the boundaries of Kneehill County, and have taken a minimum of 25 credits in final school year.

### Selection Process

The selection committee shall consist of all current Kneehill County Councillors.

The recipients will be selected on:

- Area of study and future goals in areas identified
- Academic achievement in high school
- Community and volunteer service; leadership activities
- Written essay
- Letters of reference

### Application Process

Included with your completed Application Form and signed Declaration:

- A written essay (maximum 500 words) demonstrating the importance of your choice of studies, and how your future goals and aspirations support rural communities, agriculture or rural municipal government. Essay should also highlight the role and contribution you have made to your local community and/or school through volunteer, extracurricular and leadership activities.
- Two written letters of reference. (non-relative)
- Current transcript (unofficial from High School signed by Principal is acceptable if official not yet available).
- Confirmation of enrollment and acceptance into program at post-secondary institution.
- One copy of applicant's graduation picture to be used for Kneehill County Communications only if candidate is selected. The picture will not be returned.
