Policy Title 100 Year Farm and Ranch Award	Date: July 21, 2015	Resolution No. 326/15

Purpose:

To recognize the achievement of century family farms and ranches within Kneehill County's boundaries and to honor such achievement by the presentation of a plaque.

Policy Guidelines/Procedures:

1. The amount of 100 Year Farm and Ranch Awards will be determined by Council at the annual budget deliberations and shall be counted for through General Ledger Account # 11-000-00-25130.
2. The land must be continuously owned and actively farmed or ranched by the same family, having controlling interest, for 100 or more years.
 - a. The 100 years starts from the time the land was occupied for farming or ranching, which in many cases was before the homestead title was issued.
 - b. Deeded land that has been rented to persons outside the family during the 100 years are ineligible for the award. Rental property is also ineligible.
3. The applicant must provide evidence clearly demonstrating the kinship ties between the applicant and the founder of the farm, ranch or homestead.
4. The current size of the original homestead must be at least 160 acres of land (a farm not an acreage).
5. The applicant must provide the following information:
 - a. Date of the homestead establishment
 - b. Land location
 - c. Copy of the current land title
6. A bronze plaque measuring 15" X 12" with the following inscription will be presented to the family being honoured at a regular Council meeting.




