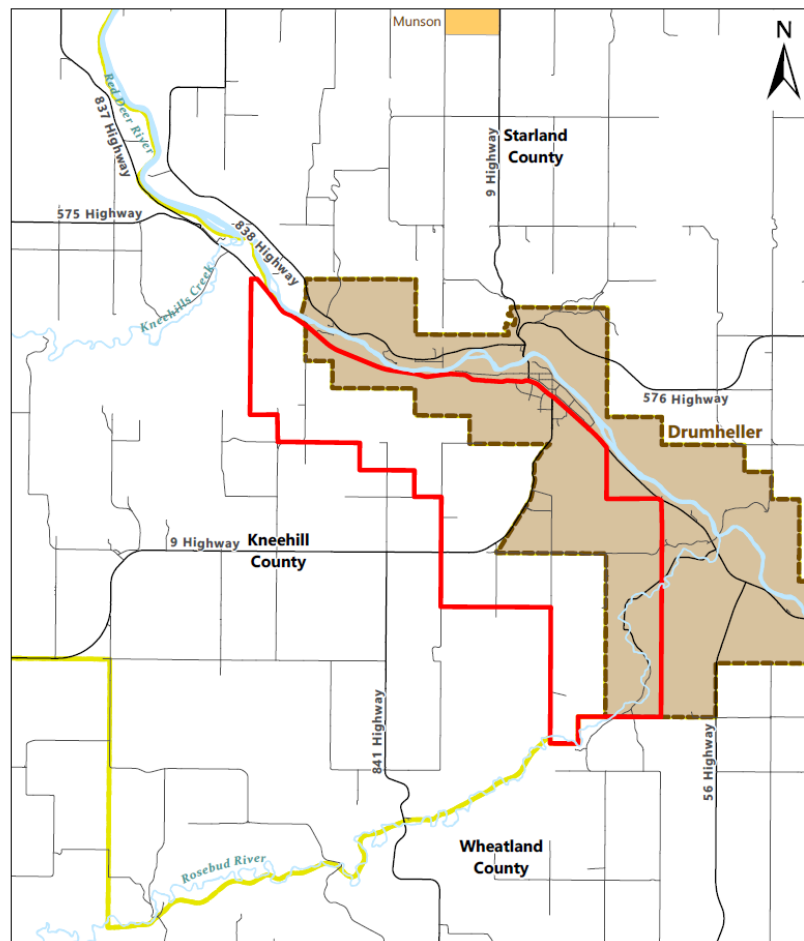
Place: Virtual Meeting, Kneehill County

Purpose

Recent changes to the Municipal Government Act have mandated that municipalities sharing a common boundary must develop an Intermunicipal Development Plan in order to foster a collaborative planning approach for these lands. These plans must be in place by April 1, 2021.

Intermunicipal Development Plans must promote consultation and cooperation between the participating municipalities regarding planning matters of joint interest within a defined planning area. They also provide a framework for processing development proposals, subdivision applications or concerns within this defined area.

The Town of Drumheller and Kneehill County have created a draft document which incorporates the requirements of the legislation.



Therefore, Take Notice that a public hearing to contemplate the proposed Bylaw 1817 will be held virtually by Kneehill County at 10:00 a.m. on the 12th day of May 2020. The meeting can be viewed through the link on the Kneehill County website.

Presentation: Written comments and suggestions are invited and should be addressed to the point of the proposed Bylaw. They may be made by any person or group of persons or a person acting on his or their behalf, who claims to be affected by the proposed bylaw, and by any other persons that Council wishes to hear at the hearing. Written submissions may be made by the persons above, and must be received in the Kneehill County Office by Noon on Friday, May 8, 2020. Public participation during the Public Hearing can be done by emailing planning.dept@kneehillcounty.com any emails received during the Public Hearing will be considered prior to second reading. It should be noted; written submissions will become public.

Individuals who have submitted a letter may only address Council at the Public Hearing on new information not contained in the letter.

Documentation: Copies of the proposed Intermunicipal Development Plan are available for public inspection on the Kneehill County website and can be emailed if requested.
